EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

The Government of Kenya has received financing, (on behalf of the Union of Comoros, Republic of Madagascar, Republic of Mauritius, Republic of Mozambique, United Republic of Tanzania, Republic of Seychelles and Republic of South Africa) from the International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) acting as an Implementing Agency for the Global Environmental Facility (GEF) (hereinafter called “Grant”) toward the cost of *South West Indian Ocean Fisheries Project (SWIOFP)*. The Borrower intends to apply a portion of the funds to eligible translation services.

As part of the SWIOFP project a series of translations are required to facilitate the timely execution of the activities of the SWIOFP. These translations are central to the successful delivery of Project outputs. Presently, SWIOFP lacks the capacity to meet these high translation demands. In an effort to meet the demand for translation and editing of materials from English to French & Portuguese and vice versa, the project is seeking the service of local, regional and international service providers with the required high-level capacity to undertake these translations in an efficient and timely manner.

The SWIOFP Regional Management Unit now invites eligible consultants to indicate their interest in providing the services. Interested consultants must provide information indicating that they are qualified to perform the services. (Proven experience in translation work; experience in marine science work is an added advantage; proven experience in editing of documents; proven ability and capacity to deliver translations to meet tight deadlines; availability of appropriate skills among staff, etc.). Consultants may associate to enhance their qualifications.

A consultant will be selected in accordance with the procedures set out in the World Bank’s *Guidelines: Selection and Employment of Consultants by World Bank Borrowers*, published in May 2004 and revised in October 2006.
